Change in Vehicle Emission notification process

In 2016 New Mexico's Motor Vehicle Department changed their computer system to comply with the Real ID requirements. In doing so, it no longer notified Bernalillo residence when their emission testing was due. MVD and Bernalillo County have been working together on a solution however, some residences still have issues which can result in a \$30.00 fee.

HERE IS WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:

You will need to have your vehicle emissions tested every 2 years unless:

Your vehicle is new. Your emissions start when your vehicle is 4 years old.

Your vehicle is 35 years or older.

Your vehicle is 10,000 pounds or more.

Your vehicle is diesel.

When you renew your registration online, you will be prompted if your emissions are due.
